The maritime gateway to peninsular India, Cochin is the fastest growing logistic center emerging into a major International transshipment terminal. The Mission of the Cochin Port Trust is to provide dependable, cost-effective Port services through modern and efficient infrastructure.

On 6.10.2012, at Cochin Port Trust office, the SMS students will get a brief introduction about Cochin Port from Traffic Manager, Dr. Unnikrishanan Nair (an Alumni of SMS) at their Conference Room. Thereafter they will arrange a site visit to the Port operational area. They will also try to obtain permission from IGTPPL for visiting ICTT, Vallarpadam.



The International Container Transshipment Terminal (ICTT), the first trans-shipment terminal in India and the first container terminal to operate in a SEZ.

A Special Purpose Vehicle, India Gateway Terminal Pvt. Ltd. (IGT) was formed for this purpose with an equity holding as listed.

The concession agreement between Cochin Port Trust and India Gateway Terminal was to operate the RGCT for a maximum period of 8 years and develop the International Container Transshipment Terminal at Vallarpadam, within this period and operate it for 30 years on a BOT basis at an estimated cost of Rs. 2400 Crores.

- Faster Truck turn around
- Multi modal connectivity
- Terminal Operating System
- Round the clock terminal operations
- E Invoicing: SMS tracking
- Check post Facilitation Centre, Walayar.
